HPC School Kids' Summer Camp 2019 "Mission Possible!"

General Information:

Registration begins - Monday, February 4, 2019

Fees and Payments:

Non-refundable Activity Fee - \$100.00

Camp Tuition:

Weekly: \$195.00 / 1st child \$175.00 / sibling

Daily: \$45.00 per day 1st child / \$40.00 per day sibling

Huntersville Presbyterian Church School Kids Summer Camp provides a weekly program for rising 1st through 8th graders. Those wishing to enroll by the day may do so *if there is space available*. You will be charged for the number of days contracted for, whether or not the child is actually in attendance during those days. **Advanced registration is required for those weeks/days your child will be attending.**

Payments will be made in advance on Friday for the following week. If your child is not in attendance that week before, payment must be made on Monday. A \$10.00 late fee will be assessed for any balance not paid by close of business on Tuesday for that week. If the account has not been paid by Friday, the child will not be permitted to return until the past due balance has been brought current. **Those families that participate in an automatic bank draft will receive a \$5.00 weekly credit.** Tuition and activity fees cover all on-site and off-site activities and field trips, 2 snacks daily, and lunch Monday through Thursday. Children will bring a packed lunch on Friday and a water bottle daily.

Automatic Bank Draft for Tuition (\$5.00 per week tuition reduction will be applied if using bank draft.)

I authorize Huntersville Presbyterian Church School Kids Program to debit my checking account weekly for tuition for my enrolled child/children for both the academic year and Summer Camp (if applicable). The amount debited will not exceed the tuition fees for the week (including possible teacher workday care as needed), and will be debited in advance on Friday for the following week.

**Huntersville Presbyterian Church School Kids
Parent Agreement**

- The HPC School Kids Summer Camp program will be open 7:00 am – 6:00 pm, Monday through Friday.
- HPC School Kids Summer Camp provides weekly programs for rising 1st – 8th graders. Children may enroll daily, *if space permits*.
- The Summer Camp Fees are as follows:
Registration/Activity Fee: \$100.00
This non-refundable fee is due upon registration and covers all on-site and off-site activities and field trips.
- **Tuition: Weekly - \$195.00 / 1st child \$175.00 / sibling**
Daily - \$45.00 / 1st child \$40.00 / sibling
- The parent/guardian agrees to pay the weekly tuition as set by the HPC School Kids Program. **All tuition fees are due in advance. The weekly/daily tuition amount for those weeks/days contracted for will be the same regardless of absences or days missed. All tuition fees are to be paid on Friday for the following week. If for any reason, except illness, the account has not been paid by the close of business on Tuesday for that week, a late fee of \$10.00 will be assessed. If the account has not been paid by the next Friday, the child will not be permitted to return until the past due account is brought current.**
- **The parent/guardian agrees to pay any and all fees incurred due to insufficient funds from returned checks or credit cards. Two (2) incidents of NSF's within one (1) year will require future payments to be made by cash or money order.**
- The parent/guardian will receive a \$5.00 per week discount on tuition if registered for an automatic bank draft. This draft will serve as payment for both summer camp and the academic year if applicable.
- Children will not be allowed to attend unless all paperwork is current.
- Children should bring a water bottle daily and a packed lunch on Fridays.
- The parent agrees to pay \$1.00 per minute, per child, late fee starting at 6:01 pm. Late fees should be paid in cash to the child's teacher and not added to tuition.
- For your child's safety and protection, and for proper record keeping, the parent/guardian will be required to sign the child out each night when picking up. Only authorized adults will be allowed to pick up your child.

School Kids' Discipline and Behavior Policy

Huntersville Presbyterian Church School Kids' Program is committed to providing children and families with high quality learning and care in a safe and loving Christian environment. A major part of this obligation is to use a system of discipline that will provide a positive experience leading each child to develop a strong sense of self-control and personal responsibility. In order to achieve these goals, we have instituted the following code of behavior for the safety and well-being of all our children.

Guidelines for Handling Discipline

- o Praise, reward and encourage children
- o Reason with and set limits for the children
- o Model appropriate behavior for the children
- o Listen to the children
- o Provide alternatives for inappropriate behavior to the children
- o Provide the children with natural and logical consequences of their behavior
- o Treat the children respectfully
- o Ignore minor behavior
- o Explain things to children on their level
- o Be consistent, firm, and loving

Types of Unacceptable Behavior

- o Hitting, kicking, or pinching
- o Wrestling or fighting
- o Spitting or biting
- o Cursing or inappropriate language
- o Defacing or destroying property
- o Taking property from other children or from the program
- o Sassing or back talking
- o Throwing food, belching, or other rude behavior at snacks and meals
- o Physical displays of violence toward caregivers or other children
- o Loud talking, screaming, hitting, or kicking while being transported in program vehicles. Seat belts must be worn at all times and may not be removed while the vehicle is in motion.

Consequences for Unacceptable Behavior include:

- o Periods of time-out from activities and/or peers
- o Removal from particular activity or classroom for extended period of time
- o Periods of exercise such as walking laps around the playground
- o Writing of apologies, papers, definitions, etc.
- o Loss of privileges.

If a child refuses to comply with these consequences, the parent will be notified.

If the Director speaks to the parent about a child's inappropriate behavior, this will be considered a warning. If a child receives three warnings within a month's time, he or she may be suspended from the Program for one week. If the child continues to misbehave and receives three more warnings, he or she may be removed from our Program.

If a child physically attacks a worker, the child will receive an automatic suspension for a week. If it happens a second time, the Director has the authority to have the child permanently removed from the Program.

Regular tuition is due during suspensions.

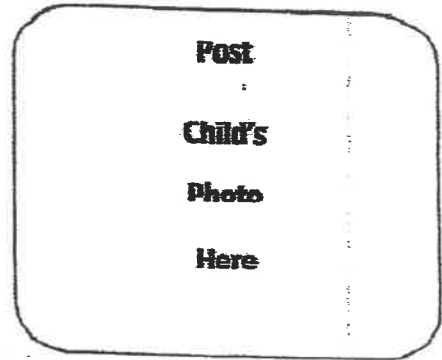

WAIVER

In the event that I cannot be reached in an emergency situation, I hereby give permission for the HPC Director or her designee to obtain medical care for my child. This may include, but not be limited to, the selection of medical personnel. I also give permission for the following as determined necessary by the Director, her designee or the selected medical personnel: ordering of x-rays, routine tests, treatment, the release of any records necessary for insurance purposes, and the provision or arrangement of necessary related transportation for my child. I also give permission to the physician selected by the HPC Director or her designee to secure and administer treatment including hospitalization for my child. I understand that no accident or medical insurance is provided for Child Care activities, and I accept the financial responsibility for any such treatment.

I give my consent for my child/children to be transported off the HPC campus in authorized vehicles to participate in authorized field trips. I give consent for my child/children to be transported to/from his school as needed. Huntersville Presbyterian Church policy requires that each child be properly buckled in a seat belt at all times while being transported. I hereby release Huntersville Presbyterian Church and its employees from any and all liability in the event of injury to my child if he/she does not abide by HPC's seat belt and behavior policies.
